16.	No silly string, confetti eggs or gum can be sold.
15.	Vendors must be prepared to make change for purchases.
14.	Beyond the placement fee, the vendor retains all profits from their sales.
13.	Vendors are responsible for filing and paying any appropriate sales tax to Jefferson Parish and the State of Louisiana.
12.	The Town will be selling beverages: soft drinks, water, beer, alcoholic beverages, etc.; vendors may not sell beverages of any kind.
11.	Seafood vendors must use Louisiana seafood.
10.	Vendors are responsible for disposing of cooking oil, water, etc. It cannot be disposed of in the festival.
9.	Vendor certifies that said food items and preparation meet all applicable laws of the State of Louisiana and the Parish of Jefferson.
8.	Vendors who are cooking or frying food on site must put a protective covering under the cookers, such as kitty litter to absorb any grease or drippings.
7.	Cooking equipment must be situated within a secure location.
6.	Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their booth area. This includes removing all trash (to be placed in the dumpster) and hosing down any spills that may occur. If booth is not cleaned, a \$50 cleaning fee will be charged.
5.	Vendors are responsible for securing their goods and/or space at night and in the event of rain.
4.	Vendors are responsible for transportation of their own goods.
3.	Vendors must be in assigned 10' x 10' tent space and set up for business one hour prior to festival opening. All vehicles must be off festival grounds two hours prior to festival opening. NO EXCEPTIONS. (Tents are provided by the Town of Jean Lafitte)
2.	Vendors will provide lights, tables, cooking equipment, food items, paper plates, utensils, paper products, etc. as its necessary to conduct business.
1.	Vendors must keep their booth open for the duration of the event, for ALL 3 days.
